Hans Huber lived and composed for 34 summers at the Villa Kapellmatt in Vitznau. His Lenzund Liebeslieder and other vocal quartets are perfect for the new chamber music hall.

The famous Swiss composer Hans Huber (1852-1921), also known as the Swiss Brahms, spent 36 summers living and composing in Vitznau, 34 of them in the Villa Kapellmatt. Vitznau was also his final resting place. Just 250 meters from the Villa Kapellmatt, the fantastic Chamber Music Hall was opened two years ago. Hans Huber's Lenz- und Liebeslieder and other vocal quartets for soloists, choir and four-hand piano could not be more fitting for this golden hall. Queens Land Classics closes the circle and enables the interested public to first learn about Hans Huber's life, work and place of activity at an aperitif in the garden of the Villa Kapellmatt and then to hear and experience his wonderful music in the Chamber Music Hall.
